A Bing space is a compact Hausdorff space in which all components are hereditarily indecomposable. We investigate those spaces X which are quotients of a Bing space Y via a surjective map  $f: Y \to X$  which has the property that the preimage of any component in X is a component in Y. The work builds on Krasinkiewicz's description of hereditarily indecomposable continua in terms of folding. (Received February 15, 2005)
