Geometric index theory assigns geometric invariants to families of Dirac operaters. The eta-invariant and Quillen's determinant line bundle are examples. Next in line, so to speak, is the index gerbe discovered by John Lott. In this talk we'll discuss a novel presentation of the index gerbe along with refined results for its geometry.
