Zilber gave an uncountably categorical nonelementary class of algebraically closed fields with exponentiation where the definable sets are well-behaved. This raises the tantalizing question of whether this class contains the complex numbers with exponentiation. We will examine some simple cases of Zilber's axioms for the complex field.
