Yu generalised a construction of Corwin and Howe for division algebras to produce many supercuspidal representations of tame p-adic groups. In this talk, we will describe how to use the Harish-Chandra integral formula to compute the characters of these representations under certain compactness conditions. In particular, all characters can be computed for "tame" division algebras (those of index coprime to p). This is joint work with Jeff Adler. (Received August 03, 2007)
