A Galois scaffold, in an extension of local fields, is a generalization of a normal basis that behaves well with respect to valuation and is thus useful for addressing questions in Galois module structure. We will describe a Galois scaffold for arbitrarily large elementary abelian p-extensions in characteristic p and present a result (joint with Nigel Byott) where this Galois scaffold is used to determine necessary and sufficient conditions for the ring of integers to be free over the associated order.
