We are interested in the ideal of polynomials $p \in \mathbb{C}[x_1, \dots, x_n]$ such that $p(\bar{f}_1, \dots, \bar{f}_n) = 0$ where (f_1, \dots, f_n) defines an automorphism of \mathbb{C}^n and the \bar{f}_i 's are the leading terms. Two general results about this ideal allow us to give a complete description of all possible relations in dimension three, at least when the ideal is principal. (Received August 11, 2008)
