We determine the relationship between the cardinality of a commutative Noetherian integral domain and the cardinality of a residue field. One consequence of the main result is that it is provable in ZFC that there is a Noetherian domain of cardinality \aleph_1 with a finite residue field, but the statement "There is a Noetherian domain of cardinality \aleph_2 with a finite residue field" is equivalent to the negation of the Continuum Hypothesis. If time permits, we will use these results to describe the ordered set Spec(R[x]), where R is a one-dimensional Noetherian domain with finitely many maximal ideals. (Received September 07, 2009)
