We study Right Angled Coxeter Groups (RACGs), and find that the automorphism group generated by partial conjugations is once again a RACG if its defining graph does not contain any separating intersection of links (SILs). In this talk I will state the key lemma and sketch its proof, along with an illustrative example. This result is then extended to more general graph products of abelian groups.
