When a compact group acts on a Hilbert space irreducibly, the orbit of any single nonzero vector forms a tight frame. When the action is not irreducible, the situation is considerably more complicated. This is especially true if one wants to use multiple generating vectors and make a frame from the disjoint union of their orbits. We tackle both generalizations at once, and give a neat duality result that captures the result for irreducible representations under the same umbrella as the familiar duality of frames and Riesz sequences.
