60614. Biproducts and Extensions: Examples. Preliminary report.

In this talk, we will discuss the biproducts of Yetter-Drinfel'd Hopf algebras constructed in the previous talk from the point of view of extensions. They are extensions of a nontrivial 16-dimensional Hopf algebra by a group of order 2. In the talk, we will explain which 16-dimensional Hopf algebra from the known classification appears and discuss whether these biproducts can also be constructed as abelian extensions.
