A triangular floorplan is a subdivision of a triangle into triangular rooms. A slicing floorplan is constructed inductively one wall at a time. We provide an enumeration of triangular floorplans with a specified number of rooms, as well as bijections to separable permutation pairs and, in the slicing case, three-dimensional rectangular floorplans.
